## Is the NDMA for you?

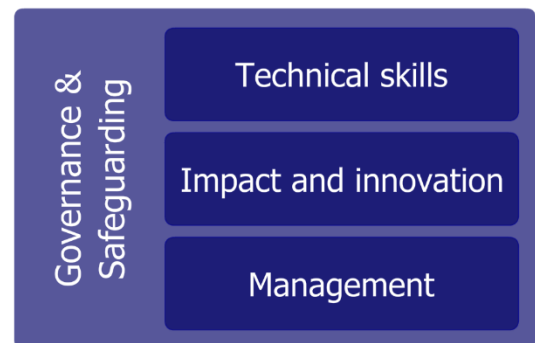
The NDMA is for data managers who:

- Are keen to understand how their role supports raising standards across the school and wider system
- Utilise data to drive the decision-making processes that help students to maximise their potential and improve their life chances
- Want to develop further their skills and processes for the handling, management of and maintenance of student data
- Want to explore career development opportunities and advance their role within school
- Want to evaluate the impact of their work to ensure practice is robust, transferable and sustainable.

## The award structure

All activities take place online – allowing you to complete tasks as and when you can. There are five key competencies within the award – they are:

- Understanding of relevant legislation
- Reflective practice
- Networking
- Understanding of national data resources and issues
- Impact on existing practice.



## Studying for the award

The estimated required study time for the award is between 22 and 32 hours and candidates will have access to peer support through an online network. Assessment focuses on both evidence gained during award study, and evidence from within twelve months prior to enrolment.
