

'The key to excellence is this: it is born from a culture. When children enter into a family culture, a community culture, or a school culture that demands and supports excellence, they work to fit into that culture. A culture of excellence transcends race, class, and geography; it doesn't matter what color, income, or background the children come from. Once those children enter a culture with a powerful ethic, that ethic becomes their norm. It's what they know.' (P6)





Creating a culture of excellence: 5 pedagogical principles

- Assign work that matters
- Study examples of excellence
- Build a culture of critique
- Require multiple revisions
- Provide examples of excellence





'The first step in encouraging high-quality student work is to have assignments that inspire and challenge students. There's only so much care and creativity that a student can put into filling in the blanks on a commercially produced worksheet.' (P65)





CRITIQUE

3 Rules:

- Be kind
- be specific
- be helpful





The Guidelines:

- Try to begin with the author/designer explaining their ideas and goals, and explaining what particular aspects of the work she is seeking help with
- Critique the work, not the person
- Try to begin critique comments with something positive about the work, and then move on to constructive criticism
- Try to use I statements when possible: "I'm confused by this," rather than, "This makes no sense"
- Try to use a question format when possible: "I'm curious why you chose to begin with this . . ?" or, "have you considered including . . ?"
